Cancer does not stop at Corona

Nevertheless, it was always clear: The Blue House is needed and must remain open. Because community is so important for families with children suffering from cancer. The Förderkreis krebskranke Kinder e.V. Stuttgart has its hands full and has been providing unbureaucratic and rapid support to children and young people with cancer and their families in Stuttgart and the region during therapy and afterwards since 1982. The Blue House is financed almost exclusively by donations.



The partial reimbursements from health insurance companies and the parents' own contribution cover only a fraction of the costs. Therefore, the support group relies on donations of approximately € 1,000,000 per year for the ongoing operation. With the handover of the SilentCare to the Blue House, FILCOM would like to give back a piece of normality to all affected families. Thus, comprehensive personal counseling on site for those seeking advice will be possible again in the future. A matter of the heart of the FILCOM team.

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
